#### **HOW TO APPLY**

If you wish to enter the Supply Chain Engineering and Management program you should have a BSc/BA degree or equivalent (minimum three years of study). Your application needs to include the following documents:

- Letter of motivation
- Curriculum vitae (CV)
- University transcript in English or German
- Bachelor's degree certificate or equivalent (may be handed in later)
- Two letters of recommendation from academic referees or industry professionals
- English language proficiency test certificate. Native speakers and applicants who completed their undergraduate studies in English may be exempt from this requirement.
