WHAT IS FINANCIAL AID?

Considering how you will finance your studies can be a daunting prospect when applying to universities. Here at Jacobs University Bremen we have a streamlined process, which aims to make this part of your university application as easy as possible. Working alongside of our Admissions Team is a dedicated Financial Aid Team, who will guide you through the process. Individualized financial aid packages, which may include grants, scholarships, and/or tuition deferral, help make it possible for students to study at our university. The tuition deferral repayment plans are shaped towards one's personal situation following graduation, taking graduate studies and placements into account.

Financial aid packages at Jacobs University may consist of:

- 1. merit-based scholarships**
- 2. need-based grants**
- 3. tuition deferral**
- 4. an expected family contribution (EFC)**

SHOULD I APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID?

Yes, all students should apply for financial aid if they think they cannot afford the cost of attendance per year with family funds or private bank loans.

HOW TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

In order to apply for financial aid, you need to fill out and submit the online financial aid application form and send the required supporting documents by regular mail or you may scan them to us.

QUICK FACTS

- 69% of our students received a grant and/or a tuition deferral
- 66% of our students received a scholarship (external and/or internal)
- Our partial merit based scholarships range in value between €1,250 and €7,500 per semester

SCHOLARSHIPS

These are merit-based funds which are awarded based on the admissions application. Scholarships do not need to be repaid. Applicants of any nationality who submit a complete admissions application via Common App will automatically be considered for a partial entrance scholarship from Jacobs University Bremen.

GRANTS

These are need-based funds that are awarded based on the need shown in your financial aid application. Grants do not need to be paid back to the university.

TUITION DEFERRAL

The Tuition Deferral Plan is similar to a loan program. Students can postpone paying part of their tuition through this deferral plan for each of the three years they are studying at Jacobs University Bremen. Students are not required to make any repayments while they are in university. After graduating or leaving Jacobs University, students receive a six-month grace period during which they do not have to make any repayments. If a student decides to enroll in a Masters program after completing the Bachelors degree then the grace period can be extended to 24 months. After the grace period, students go into repayment.

EXPECTED FAMILY CONTRIBUTION (EFC)

These are the funds that the family and/or the student can contribute to the cost of tuition and room & board. The EFC is calculated based on the financial aid application.
